Public Regulation Commission Vice Chair Becenti-Aguilar to Host Aug. 22 Meeting at Baahaali Chapter

SANTA FE – New Mexico Public Regulation Commission Vice Chair Theresa Becenti-Aguilar invites residents and other interested parties to attend a meeting with CenturyLink officials on Monday, Aug. 22.

The meeting, which begins at 1 p.m., will be held at the Baahaali Chapter south of Gallup. Vice Chair Becenti-Aguilar said she called Monday's meeting at the request of several constituents who wish to discuss telephone service-related issues.

"Ensuring that my constituents have access to quality telecommunication services remains a focal point of my work here on the Public Regulation Commission," Vice Chair Becenti-Aguilar said. "Several people have recently contacted me to voice concerns about their service; this meeting will allow them a venue to voice their concerns and I hope the dialogue will yield positive results."

To access the Baahaali Chapter, travel approximately 12 miles toward Zuni on HWY 602 before turning east on Breadsprings Road (before the Mustang Gas Station. Take Breadsprings Road east for approximately seven miles; Baahaali Chapter is on the right side of the Breadsprings Road.

Vice Chair Becenti-Aguilar said she encourages area residents to attend and offer their thoughts, concerns and suggestions regarding telecommunications service.

"It is my sincere hope that the residents and representatives of CenturyLink can work together," Vice Chair Becenti-Aguilar said. "I look forward to a dialogue that helps the constituents I serve."
