APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from Central N. M. Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant agrees to comply with and be bound by the articles of Incorporation of Cooperative, the Bylaws of Cooperative and any amendments thereto, and such Rules and Regulations as may be adopted from time to time by the Cooperative.
2. Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises and will pay therefor monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy which it shall be required to furnish to the Applicant. Applicant will pay a bill of at least \$ _____ per month regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed.
3. Applicant agrees to deposit with Cooperative a one-year's deposit in the amount shown below: It being expressly understood that such deposit shall be interest bearing at 5% for the period held, and that any portion of said deposit and interest not applied to the payment of bills due Cooperative shall be refunded to Applicant upon termination of service.
4. At the request of Cooperative, Applicant will execute and deliver to Cooperative the necessary easements and rights of way to construct, operate, maintain and repair its lines, also the right to cut or trim trees necessary to keep them clear of all parts of the electric system.
5. Applicant agrees that all poles, wires, sockets, switches and other facilities constructed or installed by the Cooperative upon the property of the Applicant shall at all times be the sole property of the Cooperative which shall have the right to remove same upon discontinuance of service.
6. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall:
 - a. constitute a contract for electric service between Applicant and Cooperative which shall continue in force until the Applicant requests service to be discontinued.
 - b. constitute an acceptance of Applicant to membership in Cooperative with such rights and privileges as are specified in the Bylaws of Cooperative, provided, however, that said membership shall terminate when Applicant ceases to purchase electric energy from the Cooperative.
7. Applicant by signing membership and becoming a member assumes no liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property is exempt from execution from any debts or liabilities.
