AVAILABILITY:

To all consumers within the Utility's service area.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Single phase, 60 Hertz, at 120/240 volts.

NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service)

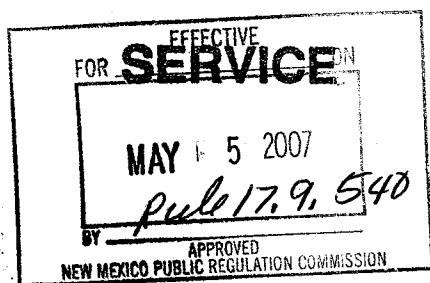
100 Watt HPS Fixture:	\$ 6.00/Billing Period	X
175 Watt Fixture:	\$10.50/Billing Period	X
400 Watt Fixture:	\$17.75/Billing Period	X

These rates, plus the adjustments set forth below, are based on average billing period consumption as follows:

100 Watt HPS Fixture:	36 kWh/Fixture/Billing Period
175 Watt Fixture:	64 kWh/Fixture/Billing Period
400 Watt Fixture:	146 kWh/Fixture/Billing Period

ADVICE NOTICE NO. 53

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MINIMUM CHARGES:

Minimum charges per billing period shall be the above rates for wattages quoted, or, as established by contract in accordance with Extension Policy or as established by special contract between the consumer and the Utility.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGES:

Minimum annual charges shall be the above net rate per billing period times twelve (12) for wattages quoted, or as established in accordance with the Utility's Line Extension Policy.

LIMITED INVESTMENT:

The maximum investment by the Utility per light installation shall be as provided by the Utility's Line Extension Policy.

BILLING PERIOD:

The billing period shall be approximately 1/12 of a year but not necessarily a calendar month.

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TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are net and payable within twenty (20) days from the date of bill. The annual rate/year is payable in advance each year.

SERVICE CHARGE:

A service charge of one and one half percent (1 & 1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent per the provisions of the tariff.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

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DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased or decreased by an amount in the cost of debt capital incurred pursuant to securities, the issuance of which has been approved by the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission, of the debt cost utilized to establish these rates. This is in accordance with New Mexico Public Regulation Commission Code of Rules and Regulations No. 540.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The utility shall, if the fuel and purchased power expense is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$.0626398/kWh sold, flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with New Mexico Public Regulation Commission Rule No. 550 (17.9.550 NMAC).

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) Security light installations and related appurtenances billed under this schedule shall be owned, operated, and maintained by the utility. All facilities installed on the consumer's premises shall be the property of the Utility.
- (2) Security light installations shall required a 60 continuous months (5 years) service agreement, or as provided by the Utility's Line Extension Policy.

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CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: (Continued)

- (3) Security light installations shall be controlled by light sensitive photo-electric cells.
- (4) Security light installations shall be maintained by the Utility only during normal working hours.
- (5) Security light installations may be inoperative during periods within a month, but such periods shall not cause the net rate per month to be adjusted.
- (6) Security light installations may be installed on a temporary basis in accordance with the rules and regulations covering temporary electric service.
- (7) The Utility reserves the right to remove lamp and appurtenances at any time in the event more than two calls per year become necessary due to vandalism or other causes over and above regular maintenance required, unless the consumer agrees to pay for the additional calls and costs incurred.
- (8) It shall be the consumer's responsibility to notify the Utility if lamp or fixture maintenance is required.
- (9) The consumer shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Utility.
- (10) The consumer's installation shall conform to City, State, and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- (11) The consumer shall not resell or share electric service with others.

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
