QUALIFYING FACILITY MAINTENANCE POWER SERVICE

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APPLICABILITY:

This rate is applicable to all Qualifying Facilities or third party customers of Qualifying Facilities to the extent compelled by General Order No. 37 of the New Mexico Public Service Commission which are located in the service territory of this Cooperative. A Qualifying Facility is a cogeneration or small power production facility that meets the definitions, standards and requirements of General Order No. 37.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Qualifying Facilities and third party customers of Qualifying Facilities shall be charged for Maintenance Power under the same retail rate schedules which would be applicable absent the generation of the Qualifying Facility.

MAINTENANCE POWER DEMAND CHARGE:

The demand charge applicable to Maintenance Power customers shall be different from any demand charge under the applicable retail rate established under TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The Maintenance Power demand charge shall be determined by multiplying the applicable retail rate demand charge by the ratio of the number of weekdays in which the maintenance power was taken to the number of weekdays in the month. No demand charge shall apply for maintenance power taken during off peak hours which are defined for the purposes of this rate schedule as 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. weekdays, and 24 hours per day on weekends and holidays.

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REQUIRED ADVANCE NOTICE:

Maintenance Power will be provided to Qualified Facilities or to third party customers of Qualifying Facilities during periods scheduled in advance with the concurrence of this Cooperative. The Qualifying Facility shall schedule such maintenance with advance notice provided in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Length of Outage</u>	<u>Advance Notice</u>
1 Calendar day	5 Calendar days
2 to 5 Calendar days	30 Calendar days
6 to 30 Calendar days	90 Calendar days

AVAILABILITY:

Maintenance Power shall be available to Qualifying Facilities or third party customers of Qualifying Facilities for a minimum of thirty days per year, scheduled outside the peak months designated below:

December through February

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

This rate schedule adopts by reference all schedules that now are or may in the future be applicable to any service rendered hereunder. Included in this adoption are all rates, terms, conditions, rules and forms that apply to such rate schedules including, but not limited to, fuel and purchased power charges (under General Order No. 28), taxes, tax adjustment charges, line extension charges, deposits, meter charges, disconnection charges, reconnection charges and all other such charges that are allowable under General Order No. 37.

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GENERAL ORDER NO. 37 APPLIED:

All words, terms and requirements of this rate schedule shall be defined and applied in compliance with and in accordance with the currently applicable revision of General Order No. 37 of the New Mexico Public Service Commission.
