QUALIFYING FACILITY INTERRUPTIBLE POWER SERVICE

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APPLICABILITY:

This rate is applicable to all Qualifying Facilities or third party customers of Qualifying Facilities to the extent compelled by General Order No. 37 of the New Mexico Public Service Commission who are located in the service territory of this Cooperative. A Qualifying Facility is a cogeneration or small power production facility that meets the definitions, standards and requirements of General Order No. 37.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Until there is a lower cost associated with the provision of interruptible service hereunder, the rate charged for such services will be under the same rate schedule which would be applicable absent the generation of the Qualifying Facility. The additional terms and conditions stated hereafter in this rate schedule shall also apply to the rendering of Interruptible Power service.

ADDITIONAL MONTHLY CUSTOMER CHARGE:

There will, for Qualifying Facilities, or third party customers of Qualifying Facilities, who request Interruptible Power service, an additional monthly customer charge of \$ 15.00 per month to cover the additional administrative costs incurred in the provision of such service.

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FACILITIES CHARGE:

Interruptible Power service customers shall, before service commences hereunder, pay the costs and expenses of any equipment installed as a result of the rendering of Interruptible Power Service. Such equipment includes, but is not limited to, electrical, metering, electronic, communication and control system devices.

ADVANCE NOTICE REQUIRED BEFORE INTERRUPTION:

Interruptible Power service customers served under this rated schedule shall provide, or be provided, advance written notice of at least five (5) days before interruption of service is requested. Such written notice shall contain an estimate of the time for which interruption of service is requested.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

This rate schedule adopts by reference all schedules that now are or may in the future be applicable to any service rendered hereunder. Included in this adoption are all rates, terms, conditions, rules and forms that apply to such rate schedules including, but not limited to, fuel and purchased power charges (under General Order No. 28), taxes, tax adjustment charges, line extension charges, deposits, meter charges, disconnection charges, reconnection charges, and all other such charges that are allowable under General Order No. 37.
