QUALIFYING FACILITY SUPPLEMENTARY POWER SERVICE

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APPLICABILITY:

This rate is applicable to all Qualifying Facilities and third party customers of Qualifying Facilities to the extent compelled by General Order No. 37 of the New Mexico Public Service Commission which are located within the service territory of this Cooperative. A Qualifying Facility is a cogeneration or small power production facility that meets the definitions, standards and requirements of General Order No. 37

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Qualifying Facilities and third party customers of Qualifying Facilities shall be charged for Supplementary Power under the same retail rate schedules that would be applicable to a retail customer having power requirements equal to the Supplementary Power requirements of the Qualifying Facility. Any ratchet enforced through "billing demand" provisions of such retail rate schedules shall also apply to Qualifying Facilities.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING QUANTITIES:

Supplementary Power used by Qualifying Facilities or third party customers of Qualifying Facilities shall be measured employing metering devices which are adequate to determine that the power being charged for is Supplementary Power. The demand interval, where applicable, shall be the same as that contained in the retail rate schedule being applied.
