**CONNECTION TO BE MADE BY COOPERATIVE'S EMPLOYEES**

- A. The Cooperative will install the necessary overhead service wires from the street, alley or road, or from the nearest pole of the Company so that the Cooperative can connect its wires directly to the point of connection on the customer's building to the customer's wires, and in such a manner that all wiring will have reasonable and unobstructed access. The Cooperative will, at its expense, connect the customer's service loop to the Cooperative's service wires at the point of contact and install the meter. All other connections and wiring shall be made at the customer's expense.
- B. The Cooperative will determine by specifications and contract, what connections will be made and what wires will be installed by the Cooperative for each underground distribution system.
- C. The customer agrees, in accepting service, that no one except the employees of the Company shall be allowed to make internal or external adjustments of any meter or any other piece of apparatus which is the property of the Cooperative.
- D. All meter installations shall have reasonable and unobstructed access to all cooperative employees for the purpose of reading, testing and maintenance of meters.
