- A. Any natural person, firm, association, corporation, business trust, partnership, federal agency, state or political subdivision or agency thereof, or body politic (each hereinafter referred to as "person," "applicant," "him" or "his") shall be eligible to become a member of, and/or, at one or more premises owned or directly occupied or used by him, to receive electric service from, Sierra Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter called the Cooperative). Membership may be obtained by written application to receive electric service and membership; provided, however, that no person shall become a member unless and until he is receiving electric service and has been accepted for membership by the Board of Trustees or the Members. No member may hold more than one membership in the Cooperative and no membership in the Cooperative shall be transferrable.
- B. Applicants agree to comply with and be bound by the Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation of the Cooperative and all rules, regulations and rates established by the Cooperative existing on the date of application and as they may thereafter be adopted and amended, sometimes referred to as the "membership obligations". Applicants agree acceptance of application shall constitute a contract for electric service between Applicant and the Cooperative, which shall continue in force until cancelled by either party or terminated when Applicant ceases to purchase electric energy from the Cooperative.
- C. The membership application shall be accompanied by any applicable service security deposit, service connection deposit or fee, facilities extension deposit, or contribution in aid of construction that may be required by the Cooperative and shall entitle the member to one service connection; fees shall be refunded if the application for service is not approved.

- D. Any former member of the Cooperative may, by the sole act of paying any outstanding account, together with any applicable service security deposit, service connection deposit or fee, facilities extension deposit, or contribution in aid of construction that may be required by the Cooperative, renew and reactivate any prior application for membership to the same effect as though the application had been newly made on the date of such payment; fees shall be refunded if the application for service is not approved.
- E. Applicant agrees, when service becomes available, that all electric energy used on the premises will be purchased from the Cooperative.
- F. All service connection fees shall be approved by and on file with the Commission.
