AVAILABILITY:

Available to all consumers within the Utility's service area and areas contiguous thereto and at established locations such that only one bill will be required. Service shall be available on a 12-month continuous, non-seasonal basis where such facilities may be operated as an integral part of the Utility's facilities. This service is not available for the lighting of public thoroughfares.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, 60 Hertz, at 120/240 volts.

NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service)

MERCURY VAPOR

175 watt fixture (metered service):	\$ 9.50/fixture	X
400 watt fixture (metered service):	\$17.00/fixture	X
175 watt fixture (non-metered service):	\$14.00/fixture	X
400 watt fixture (non-metered service):	\$24.25/fixture	X

These rates and the adjustments set forth below are based on average billing period consumptions as follows:

175 watt fixture: 78 kWh/fixture
400 watt fixture: 180 kWh/fixture

HIGH PRESSURE SODIUM

100 watt fixture, 8,500 lumen lamp:	\$10.00/fixture	X
150 watt fixture, 14,000 lumen lamp:	\$12.25/fixture	X
250 watt fixture, 27,000 lumen lamp:	\$15.50/fixture	X
400 watt fixture, 45,000 lumen lamp:	\$21.75/fixture	X

These rates and the adjustments set forth below are based on average billing period consumptions as follows:

100 watt fixture:	47 kWh/fixture
150 watt fixture:	70 kWh/fixture
250 watt fixture:	110 kWh/fixture
400 watt fixture:	176 kWh/fixture

MINIMUM BILLING PERIOD CHARGES:

Minimum charges per billing period shall be the highest of the following:

- (1) Net rate per billing period as stated above.
- (2) Minimum charges established in accordance with Line Extension Policy.
- (3) Minimum charges established by special contract between the consumer and the Utility.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall flow through to the users such increases or decreases in debt cost in accordance with 17.9.540.16 NMAC.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall, if the purchased power expense is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$.0741827/kWh sold, flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with 17.9.550.12 NMAC.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE:

A late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent per the provisions of the tariff.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are net and payable within 20 days from the date of bill.

BILLING PERIOD:

The billing period shall be approximately 1/12 of a year but not necessarily a calendar month.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) Private Area Lighting Service is supplied in accordance with the customer's written application and under the Utility's Service Regulations and this schedule. Customer shall furnish to Utility, without cost to the Utility, all rights, permits, and easements necessary to permit the installation and maintenance of Utility's facilities on, over, under and across customer's property where and as needed in providing service hereunder.
- (2) Installation of all lamps and fixtures shall be at the expense of the Utility, provided however, for service to any location where additional facilities are required, the customer shall pay to the Utility the excess cost of the installation. All such facilities shall be and remain the property of the Utility.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: (Continued)

- (3) All facilities shall be installed under agreement having an initial term of not less than three years. Additional facilities may be installed in accordance with the other provisions of this schedule. Relocation of facilities, after the same shall have been installed, will be at the customer's expense.
- (4) The Utility shall be obligated to furnish lighting from dusk to dawn, and at all times replace and repair, at its own cost and expense, all facilities where replacement is required due to normal usage.
- (5) It shall be the duty of the customer to report to the Utility the failure of any lamp, covered by agreement, to burn or to burn adequately. The Utility will perform as soon as practicable, during regular working hours, the necessary maintenance to restore proper service.
- (6) Installation may be inoperative at times but such period shall not cause the net rate per billing period to be adjusted.
- (7) The Utility reserves the right to remove lamp and appurtenances at any time in the event more than two calls per year become necessary due to vandalism or other causes over and above regular maintenance required, unless the consumer agrees to pay for the additional calls and costs incurred.
- (8) The consumer's installation shall conform to City, State, and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- (9) The consumer shall not resell or share electric service with others.
