Public lighting installed on poles to burn from dusk until dawn.

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NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service) (continued)

HIGH PRESSURE SODIUM

100 watt fixture, 8,500 lumen lamp:	\$10.00/fixture	X
150 watt fixture, 14,000 lumen lamp:	\$12.25/fixture	X
250 watt fixture, 27,000 lumen lamp:	\$15.50/fixture	X
400 watt fixture, 45,000 lumen lamp:	\$24.25/fixture	X

These rates and the adjustments set forth below are based on average billing period consumptions as follows:

100 watt fixture:	47 kWh/fixture
150 watt fixture:	70 kWh/fixture
250 watt fixture:	110 kWh/fixture
400 watt fixture:	180 kWh/fixture

MINIMUM BILLING PERIOD CHARGES:

Minimum charges per billing period shall be the highest of the following:

- (1) Net rate per billing period as stated above.
- (2) Minimum charges established in accordance with Line Extension Policy.
- (3) Minimum charges established by special contract between the consumer and the Utility.

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TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall flow through to the users such increases or decreases in debt cost in accordance with 17.9.540.16 NMAC.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall, if the purchased power expense is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$.0741827/kWh sold, flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with 17.9.550.12 NMAC.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE:

A late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent per the provisions of the tariff.

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TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are net and payable within 20 days from the date of bill.

BILLING PERIOD:

The billing period shall be approximately 1/12 of a year but not necessarily a calendar month.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) Installation of all lamps, poles and fixtures shall be at the expense of the Utility, provided however, that service to any location where more than one pole and service is required, the governmental body shall pay to the Utility the cost in place of the additional required facilities. All such facilities shall be and remain the property of the Utility.
- (2) All facilities shall be installed under an agreement having an initial term of not less than three years. Additional facilities may be installed in accordance with the other provisions of this schedule.
- (3) The Utility shall be obligated to furnish lighting from dusk to dawn and to maintain the street lighting system with normal lamp replacement, operation and maintenance.

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CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: (Continued)

- (4) The Utility will, as soon as practicable, during regular working hours, perform such maintenance as is necessary to restore proper service when it has knowledge of the failure of any lamp to burn properly.
- (5) Installations may be inoperative at times, but such periods shall not cause the net rate per billing period to be adjusted.
- (6) The consumer's installation shall conform to City, State, and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- (7) The consumer shall not resell or share electric service with others.
- (8) Special conditions of service shall be covered by contract.
- (9) The Utility's rules and regulations, filed with the regulatory body, shall apply.

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
