



RATES AND OPTIONAL RATES

Page 1 of 1

- A. The rates to be charged by and paid to the Cooperative for electric service will be the rates legally in effect and on file with the New Mexico Public Service Commission or its successors having jurisdiction. Complete schedules of all rates legally in effect will be available for public inspection.
- B. The Cooperative does not assume responsibility for selecting the rates most advantageous to the customer. However, it will assist the customer in determining which of its rates may be most advantageous to the customer. The selection, when made, shall not be retroactive and shall remain in force for a period of at least one year.
- C. All changes duly made in the filed rate affecting terms and conditions of service under the contract between the customer and the Cooperative shall apply to the contract only when and as approved by the New Mexico Public Service Commission, or other regulatory body having jurisdiction, on and after the date such changes become effective.
