RATES AND CHARGES

Page 1 of 2

A. Rate Charges:

The rates charged by and paid to the Cooperative for electric service shall be the rates legally in effect and on file with the New Mexico Public Service Commission or its successors having jurisdiction. Complete schedules of all rates legally in effect will be kept.

B. Temporary Service Charge:

When more than a single phase service drop is required to serve a temporary connection, such as a non-permanent facility or trailer, a connection charge shall be paid by the consumer as set forth in rate "Special Fees and Charges".

C. Collection Charge:

When the customer does not pay for electric service furnished him within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of a notice of delinquency, the Cooperative may make a collection charge in the event it is necessary to make collection away from the Cooperative's established payment location as set forth in rate "Special Fees and Charges".

D. Reconnect Charge: (Non-payment)


When service has been disconnected for non-payment of charges, a reconnect fee may be charged to cover some of the cost of disconnecting and reconnecting the service as set forth in rate "Special Fees and Charges".

E. Reconnect Charge: (Seasonal Service)

When service is disconnected to a seasonal customer, a reconnect charge may be made to cover some of the cost of disconnecting and reconnecting the service plus that of re-establishing records as set forth in rate "Special Fees and Charges".



When a member who is responsible for submitting a meter reading monthly fails to do so for two (2) consecutive months, a meter reading fee may be charged for having the meter read by Cooperative personnel as set forth in rate "Special Fees and Charges".
