- A. All applicants for service may be required to sign:
 - a. The Company's Standard Service Agreement; or
 - b. Such Special written contract as shall be required to cover the particular service desired.
- B. The applicant for new service shall submit an application for service and shall furnish to the Company any permits required by law for the facilities where the water service will be used. Upon arrival of such application, the Company shall have reasonable time thereafter to provide water service.
- C. A reconnection fee shall be paid by an applicant for transfer of existing service or for service which has been previously involuntarily disconnected from any system operated by the Company. In addition to the reconnection fee, the applicant shall pay all delinquent fees and charges owed to the Company.
- D. The conditions of piping and character of installation on the premises shall be subject to inspection by the Company and be approved by the appropriate government inspection agencies, and if such piping and/or installation is found to be faulty, the Company may refuse to provide service until, and after, such faulty installation has been corrected to the satisfaction of such appropriate governmental agencies or the Company. Company does not, however, assume the responsibility for such inspections and shall not be held liable for failure of such piping or installations.
- E. The Company reserves the right to limit each customer to a maximum daily average usage where circumstances warrant.
