MISCELLANEOUS FEES & CHARGES

APPLICABILITY: The miscellaneous fees and charges are applicable to all customers.

TERRITORY: Within the service area boundaries of Rose Acres, Western Terrace and Larry Vigil West Subdivisions.

DISCONNECT CHARGE:

1. If the Company disconnects water service for non-payment or if a customer makes application to the Company to disconnect water service, the Company is authorized to charge a service charge of \$15.00.

2. Tax Adjustment: Billings under this Schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, state and federal income taxes) payable by the utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

RECONNECT CHARGE:

1. If a customer makes application to the Company to restore water service previously disconnected at the same premises, the Company is authorized to charge a service fee of \$20.00.

2. Tax Adjustment: Billings under this Schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, state and federal income taxes) payable by the utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

METER TEST CHARGE:

In accordance with Company Rule 18, the Company shall provide meter testing. If the meter has been tested within the last 12 months, the Company may charge the customer a meter test charge. This charge shall be credited to the customer whenever the meter proves to be in excess of two percent (2%) in error against the customer. The meter test charge is \$15.00.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

If a security deposit is required as determined in Company Rule No. 6, it shall be determined by: A deposit for a customer shall not exceed an amount equivalent to one-sixth (1/6) of that customer's estimated (or actual) annual billings or not more than one and one-half (1 1/2) times that customers maximum monthly bill.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE:

The Company may charge \$15.00 in the event the customer's check or bank draft is returned by the Bank for insufficient funds, closed account or another appropriate reason.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All billings under this schedule are due and payable within 20 calendar days of the date of rendition of the bill.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The rules and regulations on file with and approved by the Public Service Commission and NMPSC Rules 710 through 780 apply to service under this schedule. Copies of these rules may be obtained at the Company office or from the New Mexico Public Service Commission.
