Closures, Meeting Cancellation on PRC's Horizon

SANTA FE – The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (PRC) advises members of the public, the Press, and regulated entities of a number of irregularities to the agency's operational schedule for the upcoming weeks.

The PRC will close at 12 p.m., Friday, March 25, in recognition of the Easter holiday. Operations will resume at the PERA Building in Santa Fe and the Firefighter Training Academy in Socorro at 8 a.m., Monday, March 28.

Mandatory maintenance and a total shutdown of the PERA Building will affect the PRC and two other state agencies located there – the Children, Youth & Families Division as well as the Office of the Secretary of Insurance. The PRC offices will close Friday, April 1, at 12 5 p.m., and will remain completely closed until 8 a.m., Monday, April 4. The PRC's website and email accounts will be down during this time as well.

Because this closure may prevent adherence to the requirement pertaining to posting the agenda 72-hours prior to the following week's public meeting, the Wednesday, April 6, meeting has been cancelled.

About the NMPRC

The NMPRC regulates public utilities, telecommunications companies and motor carriers operating in the State of New Mexico. It also administers the State Fire Marshal's Office, the New Mexico Firefighters Training Academy in Socorro, N.M., and the Pipeline Safety Bureau.
